Scholarship Application

Requirements for eligibility

- An applicant may be either a high school student, an undergraduate student with above average grades or a graduate student.
- A student must be pursuing a course of studies directed toward a career in exploration geophysics or a dependent of a CSEG member who will be entering university.
- Certain scholarships administered by the Trust Fund impose additional qualifications. Completion of the questionnaire will aid in determining whether an applicant meets these qualifications.
- Applicants must be a CSEG student member or have a parent who is a CSEG member. The CSEG student membership application form is available from the CSEG website (<http://cseg.ca/students/cseg-student-membership>).
- Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic performance, financial need, interest in geophysics and extra-curricular activities.

Requirements for filing applications

In the respective award year, University applications must be received on or before **November 1st**; High School applications (for students about to enter university in the fall of the respective year) must be received on or before **June 15th**. Late applications will not be considered.

Transcripts

Applications will not be considered unless accompanied by a list of courses currently in progress and an **official transcript** of your post-secondary education. If you are a first year university, technical institute or a high school student, please send your high school transcript.

References

Two letters of recommendation in support of your application are required. One must be from a professor or instructor. A letter of reference is also desirable from a past or current employer. These letters should be mailed directly to the Committee by the respective authors.

How to apply

- 1) Complete the application form and email it to csegef.scholarships@shaw.ca. Applications will be accepted between September 1 and November 1 (March 1 and June 15 for High School Applications). Late applications will not be considered.
