

Paige Maimer: CSEG Meritorious Services Award Nomination

Paige Maimer is a highly valued CSEG member that deserves recognition for her long standing volunteer efforts with the CSEG as well as additional initiatives taken on her own to promote the profession. She has spent 10 years of volunteer work with the Microseismic Users Group (MUG) starting in 2012. Throughout this same period she was on the CSEG Symposium Committee as well as contributing to the publications on the Recorder and serving as guest editor as well.

In 2022/2023 she was a CSEG Executive Board member handling the communications portfolio. The Board acknowledged and appreciated the considerable effort she put into the position which enhanced the Society's communications and overall profile.

At the onset of her career she was awarded the Best Student Presentation at the GeoConvention and has since then given numerous GeoConvention talks. It was fitting then that Paige eventually progressed to volunteer on the GeoConvention Board as a Board Member as well as the General Chair. In 2022 she also served on the first CSEG/CHOA Symposium Committee in the role of social media coordinator and branding. The success of this latter event was in part due to Paige's role in communicating the event to a broader membership.

In addition, Paige has lent her time to other CSEG committees such as the Advocacy Committee, Mentorship, and the Chief Geophysicists Forum.

Paige's initiatives like the 'Coffee with Women in Geophysics' event and the social campaign 'Meet a Geophysicist', highlighting geophysicists in different roles through various media has set her apart from other volunteers as these were initiated by Paige herself.
